THE EXPOSURE TRIANGLE**

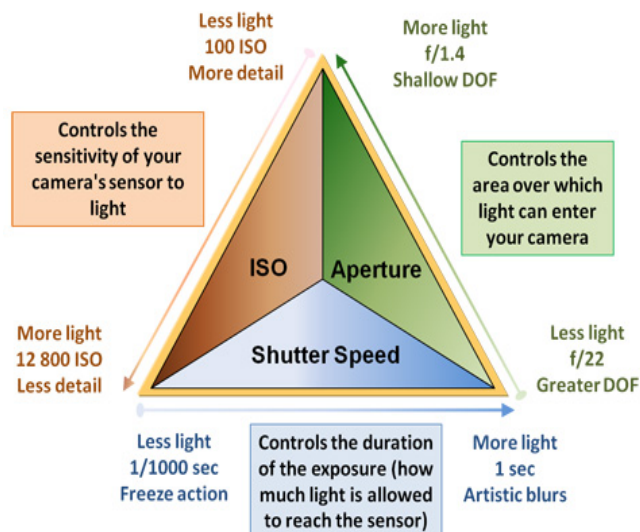
DO YOU ONLY SHOOT IN AUTO, P MODE, APERTURE PRIORITY OR SHUTTER PRIORITY? IF SO, THIS WORKSHOP IS FOR YOU!

HERE'S AN OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN ABOUT THE EXPOSURE TRIANGLE, AND HOW TO TAKE GREAT SHOTS USING MANUAL MODE.

There are three variables that determine the exposure of your shots: the aperture, shutter speed, and ISO. These three will be explained in detail during this workshop, then you will be given an opportunity to experiment with your own camera, using the props provided.

This is a real hands-on workshop, which will be followed by a field trip to Tiritiri Matangi on the 11th, run by Martin Sanders. This will be an ideal opportunity for you to shoot in manual mode and practise what you have learned about the exposure triangle. A flyer about the Tiri trip will be sent out shortly.
